Usual Deadline: 30 days prior to completion of students 1st Term or 1 week after completion of second rating earned in your program.

Amount Awarded: Up to \$5,000 to be paid out over subsequent ratings or semesters as recipient maintains scholarship criteria.

Scholarship Criteria:

1. Must be a current Aviator College student
2. FAA Written Examination score 90% or higher (non-degree)
3. Cumulative GPA of 3.4-4.0 (Degree - see the Registrar)
4. Copy of log time towards Private Pilots License. Rating Earned in FAA Minimum hours, verified with log-book and ACMS flight hour records.
5. 500 word essay describing why you chose Aviator College to study aviation
6. 2 letters of recommendation: 1 from an Aviator instructor, 1 from outside individual

Selection will be based on academic excellence, flight time completion hours, and overall qualities. Recipient will be notified by the second week of his/her second term or third rating.

Degree students- Award will be distributed over the following five (5) semesters in the amount of \$1,000.00 per term.

Non-Degree students – Award will be distributed as follows: During Instrument Rating, \$1,000, during Commercial Multi Rating, \$1,000, during Commercial Single Add-On, \$500, during Multi-Engine Instructor rating, \$1,000, during CFI Rating, \$500, during CFII Rating, \$500 and during CRJ training, \$500.

Award is contingent on recipient maintaining satisfactory academic progress and good standing within the College.
